KEYWORDS IN RUSSIAN: 5-7 words, basic general scientific terms or terms relevant to the study, ordered from general to specific

TEXT: full justification

IN-TEXT CITATIONS: State Standard (GOST), e.g. [Ivanov, p. 195], [Arnold, p. 20; Dijk, p. 68]
