She is editor-in-chief of the scientific journal *Issues of Applied Linguistics*, and joint managing editor of *Training Language and Culture* journal. Professor Malyuga is the author of over 300 publications. Her course book, *English for Economists*, was recommended for universities by the Russian Ministry of Education and Science, and *Professional Communication Language (Advertising)* was recommended by the Academic Methodological Association of the Russian Federation. In 2006, Professor Malyuga created the Business and Vocational Foreign Languages Teachers National Association, which hosts regular conferences, seminars and refresher courses on the methodology of teaching foreign languages.

Professor Evgeniya Ponomarenko (Vice Chairman)

Academician of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences, DSc in Linguistics, Professor of English Language Department No.4 at Moscow State University of International Relations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia (MGIMO University). She is author and co-author of over 110 publications, including three monographs and eight edited collections. Professor Ponomarenko specialises in functional linguistics, pragmatics, discourse analysis, rhetoric, the culture of business communication, including business English communication, linguosynergetics, theoretical grammar, and British and American studies.
